This message is called "Will you Adorn God?"

I've taught a couple of messages called Who's going in the rapture part 1 and part 2. And then I watched a video by Seven Spirits International published on 8/20/17 teaching the same thing. He called it Why Many Christians Will Miss the Rapture – The Partial Rapture

His opening scripture is a scripture I didn't have in my messages. It touched me so much that I decided to do this message. Let's check out that opening scripture...

Malachi 3:16-18 New King James Version (NKJV)
A Book of Remembrance
¹⁶ Then those who feared the LORD spoke to one another, And the LORD listened and heard them; So a book of remembrance was written before Him For those who fear the LORD And who meditate on His name.
¹⁷ "They shall be Mine," says the LORD of hosts, "On the day that I make them My jewels. ^[a] And I will spare them As a man spares his own son who serves him."
¹⁸ Then you shall again discern Between the righteous and the wicked, Between one who serves God And one who does not serve Him.

Notice His statement, "On the day that I make them My jewels", I believe God is talking about the day of the rapture. Imagine being the jewel that God wears, whether it's cuff links or a necklace, or the one earring, or a nose ring, or a pinky ring, whatever a gentleman wears to adorn himself with, He intends to make the people He raptures His jewels.

He wants to look good and He will look good wearing us, those that go in the rapture.

This is powerful because wherever He goes, He will show us off, which in turn make Him look good.

Now think about this...how do you find the perfect jewel to wear for the perfect occasion? God is looking for those who will make Him look perfect.

So the question I have for you is this: will God find you perfect on the Day of the Lord – the day of the rapture?

Let's read these scriptures again:

Malachi 3:16-18 New King James Version (NKJV)
A Book of Remembrance
¹⁶ Then those who feared the LORD spoke to one another, And the LORD listened and heard them; So a book of remembrance was written before Him For those who fear the LORD And who meditate on His name.
¹⁷ "They shall be Mine," says the LORD of hosts, "On the day that I make them My jewels." ^[a] And I will spare them As a man spares his own son who serves him." ¹⁸ Then you shall again discern Between the righteous and the wicked, Between one who serves God And one who does not serve Him.

Notice verse 16...it describes those that fit the criteria of becoming this jewel.

It's someone who:

- Fears the Lord
- Who speak with one another
- Who meditate on His Name

Do you find yourself accomplishing these things?

Whether you do or not, remember the rapture isn't for everybody but heaven is for anyone who calls upon the name of the Lord.

Meaning, you can miss the rapture and still go to heaven. It'll be harder but it is doable.

Let's pray...

Dear Heavenly Father, I ask You to forgive us of our sin, and to help us become the individual who Fear / Respect You, who talks to one another about You, and who meditates on Your name. Help us become the perfect jewel to adorn You. In Jesus' Name Amen!
